

Alpay Jan Inkilap (violin) was born in Ankara in 2001. He was admitted to the Music Preparatory Primary School of Bilkent University in 2007.

Alpay has performed as a soloist with many orchestras such as the Bilkent Youth Symphony Orchestra, Ankara Philharmonic Orchestra, Bolu Izzet Baysal University Youth Orchestra, Başkent Philharmonic Ankara Orchestra and Academic Başkent Orchestra. He has won first prize at the Gülden Turalı National Violin Competition (2013 in Turkey), second prize at the 55th International Koçianova Violin Competition (2013 in Czech Republic) and third prize at the International 7th Bravo Violin Competition (2014 in Belgium).

Being an active participant in the "Bilkent Violin Days" masterclasses held in Ankara during years 2015 and 2016, Alpay had the opportunity to work with renowned musicians and teachers, such as Alexander Vinnitski (Finland), Cihat Aşkin (Turkey), Mintcho Mintchev (Germany) and Lutsia Ibragimova. Recently, he attended the "Keshet Eilon Music Center and Violin Mastercourse" held in Israel in 2016-2017, and participated in violin masterclasses given by Itzhak Rashkovsky (England), Paul Roczek (Austria) and Qian Zhou (Singapore).

Alpay Jan Inkilap joined The Purcell School in 2017 and currently studies violin with Professor Itzhak Rashkovsky at the Royal College of Music.
